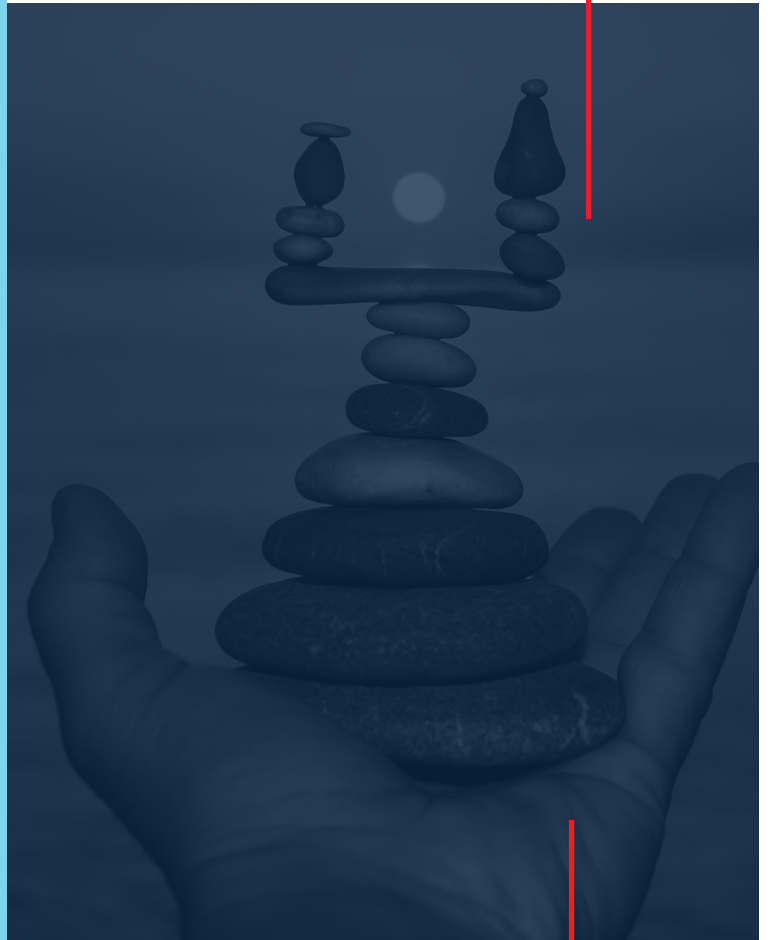

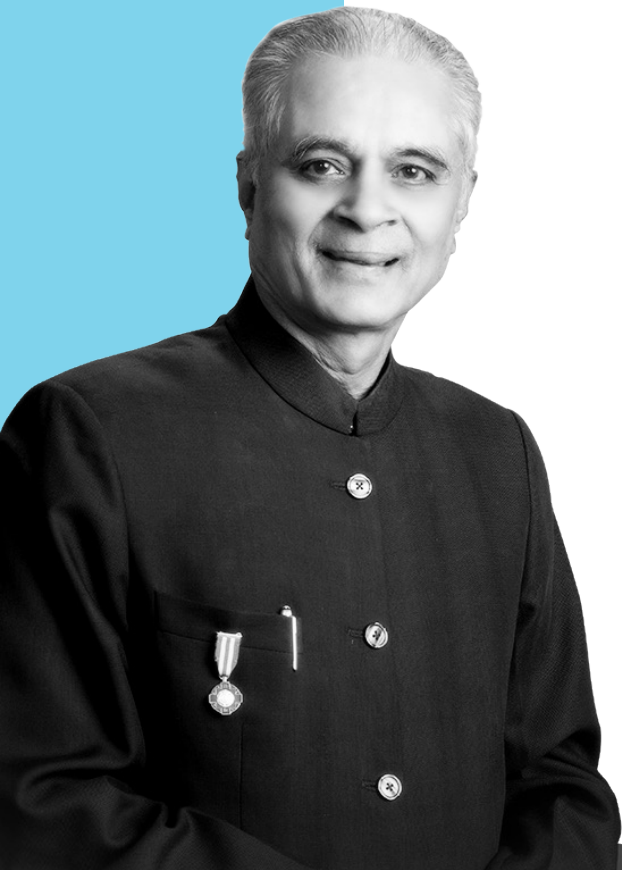

Berlin School of Economics and Law [BSEL], Germany

With approximately 10,000 students, the Berlin School of Economics and Law (BSEL) is one of the largest institutions of higher education in Germany's capital city. The BSEL is distinguished by a clear focus on providing academic education strongly linked to real world skills, an intensive and diverse programme of research, high quality standards and a strong international approach. The University's portfolio of programmes covers private and public sector business and economics, administration, law, security management and engineering.



BSEL has always regarded an international approach as an integral part of its vision and a key element in its higher education programmes and research. BSEL's international networks are constantly growing with approximately 150 partnerships with universities around the world.

In the year 2011, SIIB started a credit exchange programme with BSEL, Germany with an objective to add the dimension of Consulting in the international context to the existing MBA programme in International business. Under this programme, selected students complete 2 semesters at BSEL, in International Business & Consulting. [International Strategic Management]

Flensburg University of Applied Sciences, Germany



The Flensburg University of Applied Sciences is one of Germany's leading universities offering a wide range of Bachelors' and Masters' degree programmes. Currently, there are about 4,200 students enrolled in degree programmes mainly focused on engineering and economics.

Cooperating with partners from industry, politics, society and other educational institutions is an integral part of the activities at Flensburg. It has more than 60 universities on 5 continents as partner universities. Its rich experience of more than 20 years in international relations and exchange programmes benefits students and gives them an opportunity to broaden their horizons and improve their foreign language skills during their studies.

In the year 2018, SIIB started a semester exchange program with Flensburg University of Applied Sciences, Germany. Under this programme, the selected students spend one full semester to study a mixture of knowledge-based learning through classroom sessions and skills-based learning, including projects and group assignments.

Dauphine University, Paris

The Dauphine University, Paris which is the capital of France, is a public university specialized in Organization and Decision Sciences, recognized for its multi-disciplinary approach, by its stakeholders on national and international levels.



It has a strength of almost 11,000 students with 23% being international students from 40 different countries. Students are encouraged to participate in a variety of activities through more than 40 student associations on campus and 30 athletic disciplines.

The university hosts six research centers, all within the sector of Decision and Organization Sciences. Dauphine University has developed international relationships with 314 top-ranked universities across the world. The university holds close ties to the business world: internships, apprenticeship contracts and research chairs and corporate partnerships are merely a few examples of Paris-Dauphine.

In the year 2016, SIIB started a semester exchange programme with Dauphine University, Paris, France. Selected students spend one semester in Dauphine University, Paris. The programme gives international exposure to the students and equips them to face the world as future global managers. Also, the programme facilitates students to learn about the business environment and cultural diversity of the host country.

Leeds Beckett University, UK



Leeds Beckett University (LBU), is a public university in Leeds, West Yorkshire, England. They are located across two campuses in Headingley and the city centre.

Leeds Beckett University has various university schools such as Arts, Technology & Engineering, Business, Clinical & Applied Sciences, Cultural Studies & Humanities, Education, Events, Tourism & Hospitality Management, Health & Community Studies, Law, Department of Languages, Social Sciences and Sport.

SIU and LBU have had a long-standing relationship of over a decade and has been collaborating in many aspects including student and faculty exchanges, research and joint research proposals.

In the year 2018, SIIB started a semester exchange programme with Leeds Beckett University, UK. Selected students would spend one semester from March to July in Leeds Beckett University, UK

Leibniz University Hannover, Germany

Leibniz University of Hannover has more than 30,000 students studying in 9 faculties including the natural sciences and engineering, humanities and social sciences as well in law and economics.



The University offers many post graduate programmes in subjects like Engineering, Economics, Management, Natural Sciences, Humanities. They also offer niche courses related to the International Horticulture, International Agriculture Policy, Development Theory and Policy, Econometrics etc. The institute maintains active research relationships with several international organizations especially in food production, agriculture and natural resources. Contacts to universities in developing countries as well as in the USA and Europe underline the institute's international orientation. SIU and Leibniz have had an active collaboration for more than a decade and are active partners for many activities including semester exchanges, summer schools and research.

In the year 2019, SIIB started a semester exchange program with Leibniz University, Hannover Germany where selected students would spend one semester from April to mid of July at the university.

RUDN University, Russia

The Peoples' Friendship University of Russia also known as RUDN University, is an educational and research institution located in Moscow. It was established in 1960 to provide higher education and is known as a multinational and multi-profiled university.



Academic and residential buildings are spread in an area of 50 hectares close to the forest plantation zone and include stadiums, gyms, arenas, tennis courts and a ski center creating favorable conditions for sport activities all year round. With a student strength of 22500, it is the first university in Russia to get 5 QS stars.

RUDN leads among Russian universities in the number of English-taught master's programmes and covers all subjects including Humanities, Social Sciences, Management, Natural Sciences, Economics and even foreign languages.

In the year 2019, SIIB started a semester exchange program with RUDN university, Russia. Selected students would spend one semester approximately from March to July in RUDN University, Russia. The study involves a mixture of knowledge-based learning through classroom sessions and skills-based learning through projects and group assignments.

Munich University of Applied Sciences (MUAS), Germany



Munich University of Applied Sciences (MUAS) is the second largest university of applied sciences in Germany. They have a student strength of approximately 18,500 students and have an option to choose from 84 UG and PG programmes in 14 departments.

MUAS ranks among the top 250 Universities in the European Teaching ranking as per the Times Higher education rankings. It offers a range of courses in Mathematics, Computer Science, Natural Sciences and Engineering, Business, Social Sciences and Public Health, Architecture and Design etc. MUAS collaborates with more than 200 partner universities in Europe, North and South America and Asia. International students make up 13% of the student body offering options like student exchanges, summer schools in niche courses.

In the year 2012, SIIB started a semester exchange programme with Munich University of Applied Sciences, Germany. The summer school is a two-week-program approximate in the month of July intended for students who want to experience Supply Chain and Operational Management not only in theory but also in practice at world class companies.

Hochschule Bremen University of Applied Sciences, Germany

Hochschule Bremen University of Applied Sciences, Germany is a leading University in Germany offering courses in Economics, Architecture, Building and Environment, Social Sciences, Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, Nature and Technology. In the year 2015, SIIB started a Summer School programme with Hochschule Bremen University of Applied Sciences, Germany. Being an International Business Institute, this programme is extremely beneficial to the students, as they get a chance to have a first-hand experience of global trade practices during their visit. It is truly a blend of classroom sessions and industry visits.



During the summer school students of SIIB get an opportunity to interact with many leading personalities visiting the school on various topics. These include lectures and intensive course work, guided historical and cultural tour of the town center and visits to industries. Students during the summer school are also provided with field experience through industry visits to manufacturing industries, financial stock exchanges etc.

Lisbon School of Economics and Management, Portugal



Lisbon School of Economics and Management, Portugal is part of the University of Lisbon, the largest of the Portuguese universities. Well-recognized nationally, ISEG is likewise establishing itself as a respected international name. ISEG and Symbiosis International (Deemed University) share common interests and objectives in academic and cultural fields.

Under this programme, the selected students from the ISEG spend one full semester in SIIB, Pune. On day two the theme for Session three was 'Future of Work Post Pandemic - Global Food Chain' and for session four was 'Future of Work Post Pandemic: Sustainability Next'



Session one on 'Future of Work Post Pandemic in Diplomacy': The session started by welcoming the moderator, guest panel along with Pro-Chancellor, Chancellor, Director, Dy. Director, students all over the country and industry professionals present in the audience. The event started with a short video that captured the essence of the topic and was followed by an introductory note by our Director Dr. Asmita Chitnis. Further, the Pro-Chancellor of SIU, Dr. Vidya Yeravdekar spoke about the future of work during the pandemic, especially how SIIB's pedagogy embraced the digitalization with the shifting tides which was further corroborated by the Chancellor of SIU, Dr. S.B. Mujumdar. The moderator for the session was Amb. Gautam Bambawale, Former Indian Ambassador to Bhutan, Pakistan and China. He spoke about the remote working trends and how virtual interaction became the new normal by citing PM Modi and his G20 Meeting & SAARC meeting. He also stressed the importance of technology and how it is going to shape lives in the future. The keynote speakers for the event included Amb. Talmiz Ahmad, Former Indian Ambassador to Saudi Arabia, Oman, UAE, and Dr. Jürgen Morhard Consul General of the Federal Republic of Germany in Mumbai.

Amb. Ahmad spoke about innovation and highlighted the gap in technology that exists between the developing and developed countries. Dr. Jürgen Morhard elaborated on how diplomacy is a broad aspect and how classical diplomacy prevents conflicts. The session was later concluded with a thank you note by Dy. Director, Dr. Prakash Rao.

Session two on "Future of Work Post Pandemic: Global Perspective": The keynote speakers for the event were Mr. Vaibhav Pitale, Managing Director of India and South West Asia at Belimo, Mr. Jivesh Govil, Sr. Director, Veritas Technologies LLC, Mr. Ashish Chhabra, Vice President, Deutsche Bank, Dr. Abhay Sinha, Deputy Director General, Services Export Promotion Council.

Mr. Pitale spoke about the pandemic and how it can be seen both as a crisis and an opportunity and further elaborated on how important it is for global leaders to carve a way for the future and have a sense of optimism. An alumnus of SIIB, Mr. Ashish Chhabra touched upon how with digitalization, a lot of businesses across various sectors will get outdated, and new skills are required to meet the new demands. He also stressed on how working from home may affect productivity, and one needs to be adaptable, inquisitive, flexible and fluid to match what the world demands in the future. Mr. Govil spoke about digital transformation and automation touching all sectors and how this will affect us only in positive ways; be it income, business. Dr. Sinha raised an important question on whether we have enough resources to take virtual education to the rural sector as well or will it be confined to urban areas only.

The session was concluded with a thank you note by Dr. Sandeep Solanki and the launch of the "Catalyst" magazine by Markadiction, the Marketing club.

Session three on Future of Work Post Pandemic: Global Food Chain": The keynote speakers for the event were Mr. Dilip Rajan, Managing Director- East-West Seed, Mr. Atul Mehra, Chairman of M/S Tasty Dairy Specialties Ltd and founder of INDUCED, Mr. Abhijit Duragkar, Vice President- Global Gourmet Pvt. Ltd., Mr. Praveen Wagh, General Manager at Reliance Retail.

Mr. Dilip Rajan, who stressed how Agriculture is the forerunner in today's crisis. He also mentioned the three recessions the Indian Economy has gone through in 1958, 1955, and 1980, followed by the one we are facing currently. Mr. Atul Mehra, who compared the situation of the milk industry in the pre and post-Covid era and how we have managed to emerge as the biggest milk-producing nation after the significant movement that was 'Operation Flood'. Mr. Abhijit Duragkar, who mainly stressed Operational management, Audit and changing Consumer behaviour as the main factors in establishing a product in the market. Mr. Praveen Wagh who gave us valuable insight into the impact of Covid on the Retail Industry.

The session was later concluded with a thank you note by Dr. Ravi Sharma, Assistant Professor in the Department of Energy and Environment.

Session four on Future of Work Post Pandemic: Sustainability Next": The keynote speakers for the event were Mr. Santhosh Jayaram, Partner & Head - Sustainability and CSR Advisory of KPMG, Mr. Arvind Bodhankar - Jt. Executive President & Chief Sustainability Officer - UltraTech Cement Ltd and Mr. Gautham R K, Director - Sustainability - Cushman & Wakefield, India

Mr. Santhosh Jayaram started by saying that this year is an 'age of consequence'. He elaborated on the comparison of humans to elks in Yellowstone national park in the USA. He gave the Blackstone example of investors becoming climate activists. He said that there will be more caution, more black swans and green swans in the future and that there will be a new order of consumerism.

Mr. Arvind Bodhankar focused on three attributes that were business continuity, risk assessment and crisis management. Mr. Gautham R K talked about conferences with the future of business in the Post-Covid era and elaborated on three factors namely Downside, Upside and Opportunity.

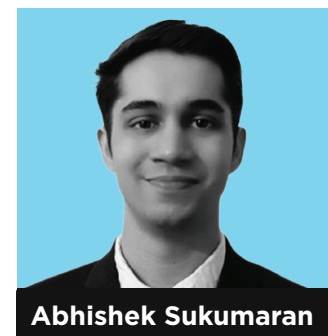
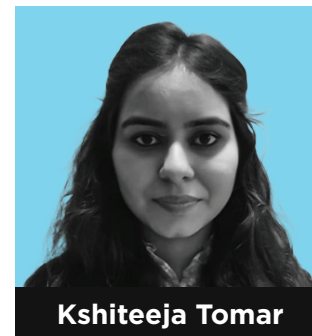
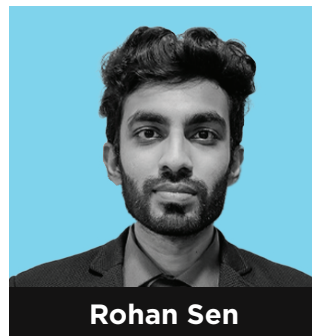
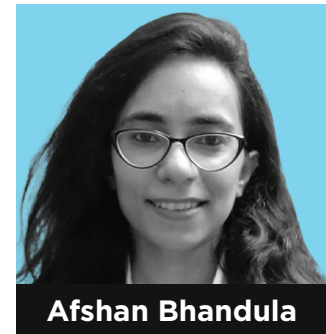
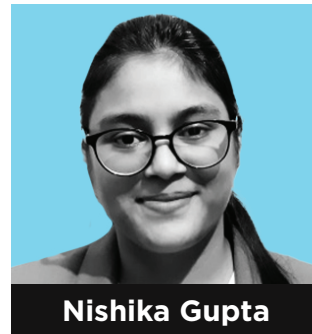
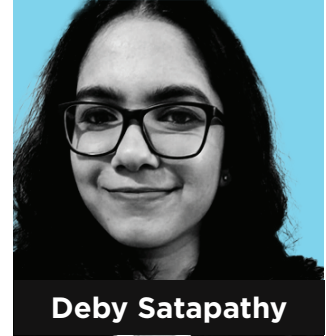
PLACEMENT TEAM:
